 Stakeholders and champions: plan, implementation, monitoring and evaluation, network, advocacy effort







PRIORITY FOR ADVOCACY


- Establish working groups and select operational districts

- **■**Develop annual work plan
- Assist in program implementation
- Monitor progress using cascade model

 - ✓ Increased fp planning budget at district level
 - ✓ Improved service quality and access to lapm
 - √ Conducive public policy related to FP

 - Using AFP's approach


Lessons Learned Work closely with provincial FP stakeholders, particularly **Provincial Health** Office and BkkbN, to assist districts

Diffusion Plan

2013

- Four Provinces: West Kalimantan, North Sumatera, East Nusatenggara and West Java
- Trained 90 national and provincial officers on Netmap, SmartChart and Cost Projection

2014

- Four Provinces: East Java, South Sulawesi, Maluku and Papua
- Advocacy Training for District Officers
- Technical Assistance for 2 districts of 4 provinces


