2017 Expansion

- Katavi, Manyara and Simiyu Regions – a total of 16 District Councils.
- Youth Coalition with seven CSOs working in six regions, and Zanzibar – Mbeya, Tanga, Morogoro, Dodoma, Lindi, and Mtwara,
- Tanzania Parliamentary Association on Population and Development (TPAPD) – 44 Members of Parliament.

Major Advocacy Wins

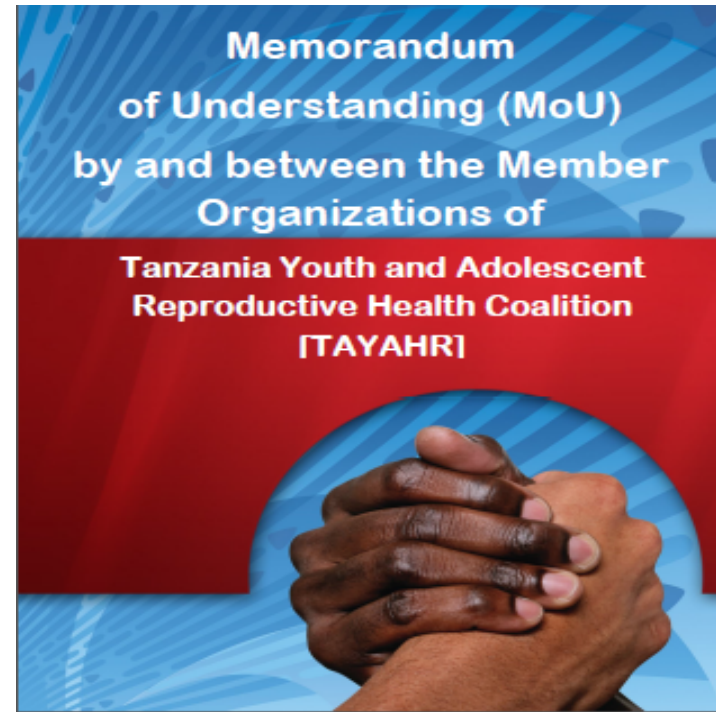
National

1. **Tshs. 7 Billion (US\$ 3.2 Million)** allocated for FP for 2017/18 (up from **Tshs. 5 Billion US\$ 2.2 Million for 2016/17**);
2. Five private member companies of the Malaria Safe Consortium have committed to invest in FP services; *Tanzania Association of Pharmaceutical Industries (TAPI)*
3. Zanzibar Health Minister commits to increase FP resources; sets up and chairs National FP Committee to provide strategic direction on the Isles' CPR increase.
4. Two more health private health insurance companies – Resolution, and Jubilee – join AAR and Strategies – in integrating FP in their health insurance packages.

Major Advocacy Wins ...

National:

5. Tanzania Parliamentary Association on Population and Development (TPAPD) declared support to enhance FP services and accountability (last mile).



6. TAYARH Coalition of seven Youth-led organizations have an MoU to strengthen FP advocacy, SRHR, and diffusion of AFP SMART

Major Advocacy Wins

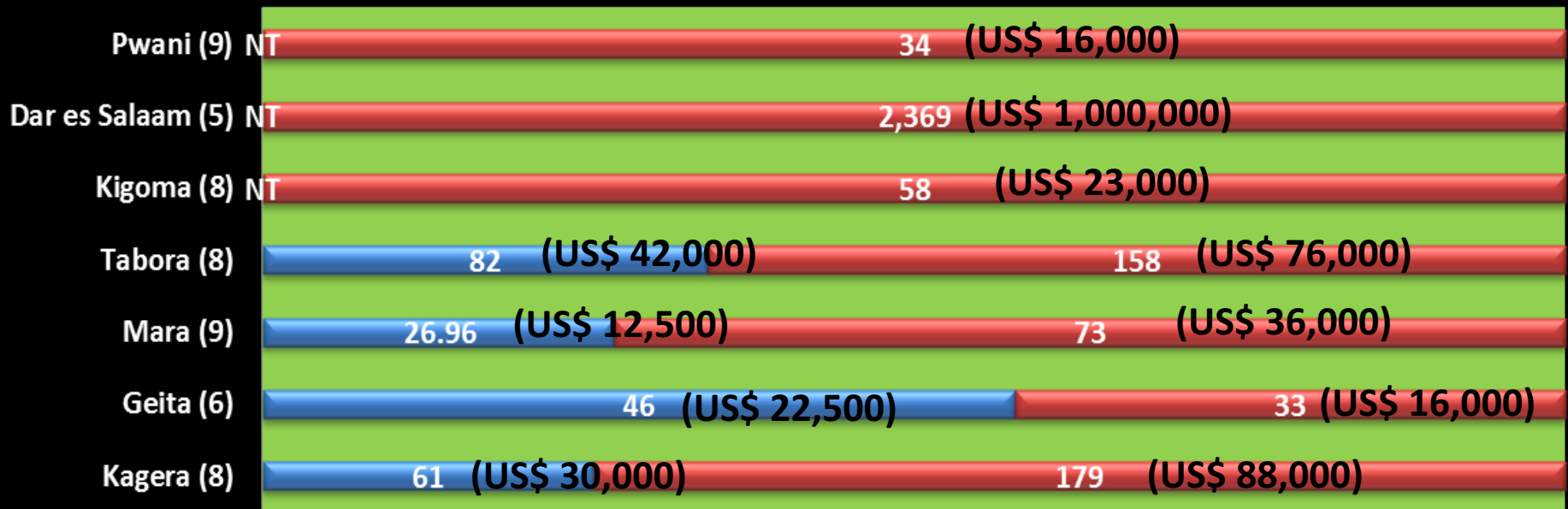
Subnational

1. Forty-five LGAs in six Regions (Kigoma, Tabora, Dar es Salaam, Coast, Katavi and Manyara) – through regionalized approach – have allocated 2% of their 'own' funds for FP services in the 2017/18.

2. Mara Region issues a directive to its 9 LGAs demanding that they allocate 5% of their health budgets to FP

Increased FP allocations in seven selected regions

From Advocacy Wins to Impact

- Private corporates support to FP – potential to increase FP uptake, and sustained FP efforts (*Malaria Safe companies*); *TZ Association of Pharmaceutical Industries (TAPI)*;
- TPAPD's commitment to increased funding and enhanced accountability in FP – potential to commodities reaching the **last mile**; strengthened FP interventions at national and council level (*Declaration of Commitment*)
- Four out five private health insurance companies supporting FP in Tanzania – potential to increased access to FP information, services and supplies. (*AAR already reaching more than 5,000 clients*).
- **Tracking** of 2016/17 budgets in four regions – Mara, Kagera, Geita, and Tabora - shows budget allocation increases of up to five folds.

Advancing FP advocacy in future

- Strengthen capacity of champion groups at community level to advocate for post-partum Family Planning where FP demand is 74%;
- Facilitate the youth coalition to reach out to youth-led CSOs to broaden youth engagement in FP advocacy.
- Build in-country advocacy capacity to consistently produce evidence-based district council data for enhanced FP advocacy.

TANZANIA: FP ADVOCACY COVERAGE

Tanzania consists of **31** regions, **196 Local Government Authorities** that constitute **5** city councils, and **191** municipal, town, and district councils.

AFP in **12** regions, and **73** districts.
