PPD ARO Advocacy Priorities

1- Global/Regional Objectives

- Champion family planning issues in FP2020 and in other global forums
- Improve funding and policy environment for Family planning in line with FP2020 commitment in Selected AFP Focus Countries

2- National Objectives (UGANDA)

Enhance accountability and transparency for FP2020 commitment

Achievements: Quick Win Increased public expenditure for FP/RH

- Uganda: Fulfillment of the FP2020 financial commitment (FY 2014-15)
 - Allocations: \$7.6 Millions (\$3.3 M Vote 116, \$4.3 GoU HSSP WB loan)
 - Expenditures: \$6.5 Millions (86% of total funds allocated)

Malawi:

- Increased Government budget for FP from K26 million (\$78,787) in FY2013-14 to K60 million in FY 2014-15 (all amount has been spent on procurement of injectables)
- MPs succeeded in re-tabling and passing a bill at parliament banning child marriage (Legal age of marriage increased from 15 to 18 years)

Lessons learnt and challenges

What is going well?

- Facilitating and working with policymakers/FP champions
- SMART Chart tools
- Ensuring follow-up
- Working through strong partnerships at all levels

What are the challenges?

- Ensuring that the allocated fund in translated into expenditures requires time,
 skills and more \$\$\$\$
- Operating within a weak health system!
