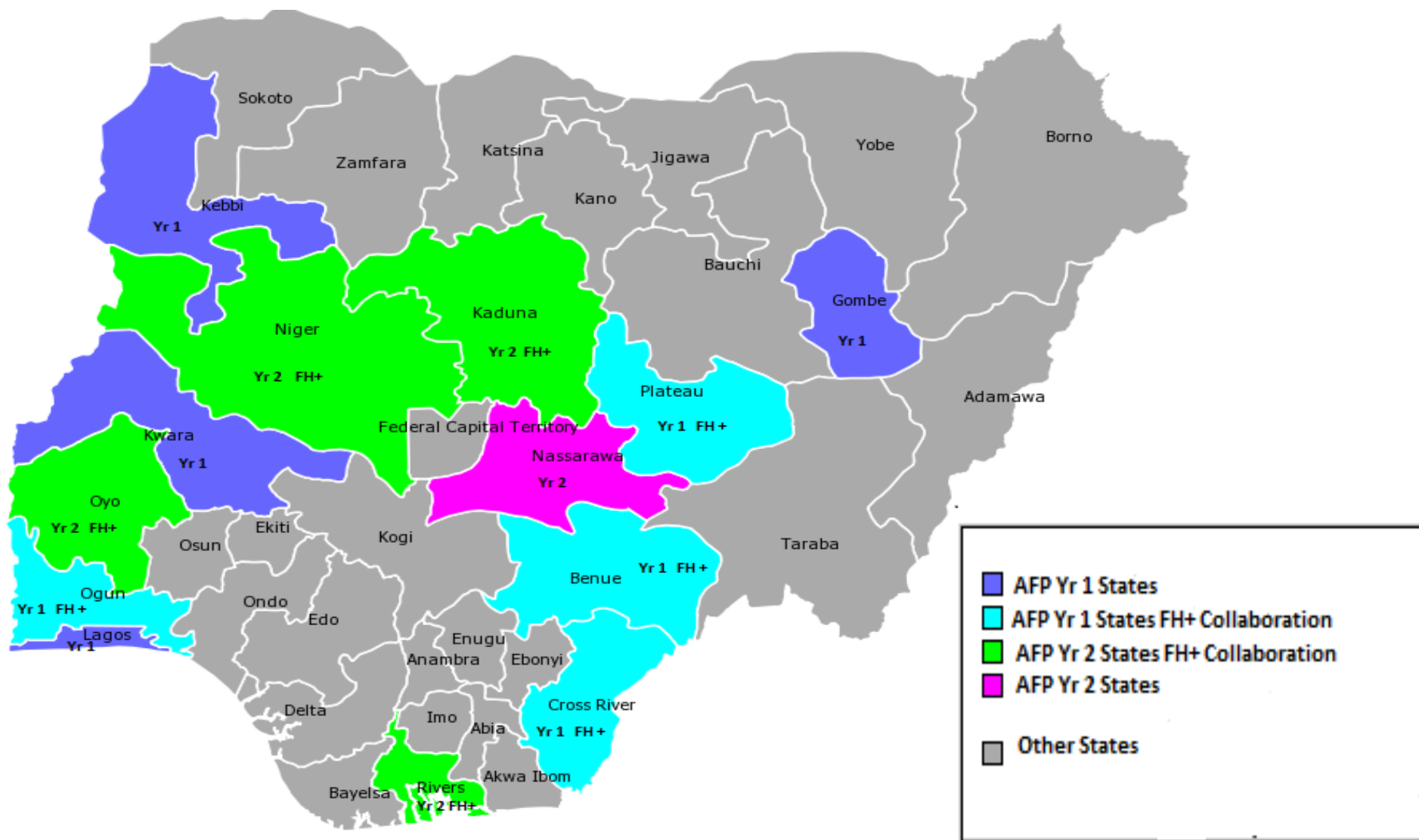

Budget line of N35,551,471.25 (\$110,000) for FP created in 2017 state budget

QUICK WIN TO IMPACT

Medical Officers of Health in Lagos State commit to continuous funding for FP consumables

March 2016-

Nov 2016 – PHCs in
Yaba LCDA now
routinely fund
monthly FP
consumables from
their imprests.

Feb 2016 – Commissioner for
Health directs removal of fees
for consumables.
