Expansion of AFP advocacy

National objectives

- 1. The DSRSE develops an implementation plan for the RH law's application decree by September 2017.
- 2. The Minister of Health and Social Action increases its budget line for the purchase of contraceptive products from 300,000,000 to 500,000,000 by October 2017.
- The Minister of Health and Social Action signs a government directive authorizing the promotion of self-injection of Sayana Press by July 2017
- 4. The Minister of Health and Social Action signs a memo/directive for the free provision of Post-Partum Family Planning (PPFP) services by September 2017.
- 5. The FP Action Plan of the Minister of Health and Social Action incudes the free provision of FP services using funds allocated by the communes.

Commune-level objectives

- 1. Obtain financial support to FP in 15 communes (August 2017).
- 2. Draft a monitoring report on the communes' commitments in favor of FP.

Major Advocacy Wins

- Commitment from 15 mayors to fund FP activities in their 2017 budget
- Review of the decree by the Technical Review
 Committee for legislative documents: withdrawal of
 Article 8 restricting the prescription of the EC by
 CHWs.





From Advocacy Wins to Impact

- 21,100,000 mobilized from 20 mayors, allowing to organize 52 fair consultations and recruit 3,692 women. We have 20 CIP validated by the 20 mayors.
- To date, we have 961 additional female users
- Contribution to increasing the contraceptive prevalence rate.
