



## What is Going Well?



- District level engagement and responsiveness towards FP;
- Broadened and collective action (govt/partners)
   on tracking, data gathering (eLMIS)
- Increased partner coordination in FP outreach approaches eg Service Delivery Organizations (SDOs) and the Green Star campaign; SDOs and HLIs SRH/FP services; engaging religious leaders

## What is not going well?

 Procurement Regulations Amendment multiple interests; Govt bias against broad stakeholders participation esp CSOs;
