Impact of Family Planning in Migori County

- Increased Family Planning investment to achieve an mCPR of 52% and shift towards long acting methods saves more lives and money for the county.
- With the increased use of long acting and permanent methods the county would:
 - Save the lives of more than 900 mothers and 4500 children
 - Save 82.7 million Kshs in terms of healthcare costs
 - Avert over 245,000 unintended pregnancies
 - By 2022, every 103 Kshs spent on FP would save nearly 605 KSH in near-term healthcare costs
- The **benefits** of investing in **Family Planning** activities trainings, commodity re-distribution and supplies, postpartum FP and adolescent sexual health **far outweigh the costs**.


