Advocacy Quickwins

- 1. AFP SMART approach was adopted nationwide.

 BKKBN adopted the approach and change the name it BKKBN SMART.

 Together with MyChoice project, AFP contributed in the efforts. (National)
- 2. An agreement was issued to address certification issues. Medical doctors and midwives who have received trainings between 2006-2011 will be certified. (National)
- 3. 3 PWG and 5 DWG* are still actively running after AFP. All districts have been graduated since 2017. (Subnational)
- 4. US\$1,142,512 was allocated in AFP-supported districts** local budget (2018) for FP program. (Subnational)


Diffusion

In 2018 – 2019, the AFP SMART approach has been adopted and implemented:

- 1. in 34 provinces and 170 districts/cities
- 2. by several CSOs, such as **LKNU** (for Diabetes Mellitus project) and **Aisyiah**.

Sustainability Quickwins

- In 2017, only **3 provinces** allocated **US\$98,617** for working group operations.
- In 2018, **3 provinces and 5 districts** allocated **US\$178,299** for the working group operations.
