









AFP Tanzania's Geographies 2019



Major Advocacy Wins

- 56.4 Billion TZS (US \$22.7 million) allocated for FP (2010-2018) from national and sub-national own sources. 2018/19 GoT allocated 22.5 Billion TZS (\$10 m); 45 times the 2010 allocations.
- June 2018, GoT abolished donation fees (0.5% per shipment) charged on RH commodities plus contraceptives
