Jhansi – A Glimpse

1. Jhansi division has three districts – Jhansi, Jaluan and Lalitpur
2. Jhansi district covers a population of 0.20 crore (Census 2011)

3. Major Indicators:

Total Fertility Rate	2.3 (AHS 2012)	Current use of any modern method	54.7
Total Unmet Need	8.5	Female Sterilization	44.3

4. DWG Jhansi was operationalised in **July 2015** in the first phase

District Working Group - What is Different?

1. The AFP SMART Approach after formation of DWG in 2015 enables rational strategy
2. Helps delving into the issues and comes out with solutions
3. Sets timeline and accountability
4. All efforts are measurable
5. Recognition/ Appreciation / Quick wins as morale booster
6. Convergence Model is crucial

Sustaining Effort

1. Evidence to show that the DWG model (convergence model) works
2. DWG model versus the use of AFP SMART approach
3. District needs time to nurture through engagement and mentorship
4. Ownership from the national/ state level to sustain the effort
5. DWG / AFP SMART approach becomes internal part of the system
